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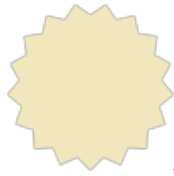
North Americans and their Burgundian ways

The most geographically energetic example of this is the new range of three Chardonnays made by Canadian...

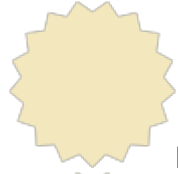
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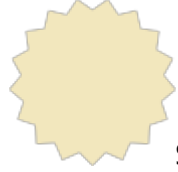
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
